
In addition to showcasing great works, the fair also honors outstanding artists for quality, technique and originality with awards and cash prizes.

About the Judge Bill Littleiohn



After studying with several great art teachers including Tim Hulstrom and Curt Winnega (Roseville Community Schools), Fred Attebury (Wayne State University), and August Gloss (Starkweather Art Gallery), Bill Littlejohn continues a strong tradition of being an artist and a teacher. Littlejohn taught studio art, photography, digital video and computer graphics at De La Salle Collegiate High School and Austin Catholic High School. While at Wayne State University, he earned a master's degree in art education with a concentration in watercolor painting.

Littlejohn paints pastels on archival-quality sanded papers, and he uses the best quality pastels available. He uses the traditional method when using pastels, working from the darks of the painting to the lights and

finishing with the highlights. Pastels suit his method of working in landscape painting when painting en plein air, which means he paints on-site rather than in an artist's studio. By working en plein air, Littlejohn feels drawing, observational and compositional skills are honed more quickly than relying on photographic references. Littlejohn also paints in acrylics using much the same dark-to-light method and archival-grade materials.

Littlejohn likes to interpret common objects such as a snow-covered field in St. Clair, traffic lights, an American flag on his front porch, light raking across hills in Romeo, a parking lot in Mount Clemens or rowboats in Lakeville. He observes these scenes then filters them through his sense of composition and use of color. Littlejohn enjoys the challenge of taking subjects that people see every day and working with them until they are more beautiful than might be seen at first blush. Littlejohn also enjoys creating surrealistic paintings that let his imagination combine realistic subjects with a surprising twist. These pieces ask the art viewer to help create meaning and intent for themselves.
